## **CITIZEN POLICE ADVISORY REVIEW BOARD SEEKS THREE RESIDENTS TO FILL VACANCIES**

The Citizen Police Advisory Review Board (CPARB) is accepting applications to fill three advisory, non-voting positions for a period not to exceed two years.

Formed by the Mayor and City Council in March 1997, CPARB helps promote a citizen-police partnership, and reviews and comments on police investigation of citizen complaints.

Advisory members must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a resident of the city of Tucson
- Must never have been convicted of a felony
- Must not currently be a peace officer
- Must attend monthly meetings of CPARB
- Must participate in Board activities including appropriate training

Persons interested in becoming an advisory member to CPARB should submit a letter of interest (not to exceed three pages) with the following information:

- Complete name, address and telephone number
- Brief description of prior and current community involvement
- A brief summary as to what the applicant hopes to accomplish by working with CPARB
