

Citizen Police Advisory Review Board Seeks Three City Of Tucson Residents To Fill Vacancies

The Citizen Police Advisory Review Board (CPARB) is accepting applications to fill three non-voting advisory positions for a period not to exceed two years.

Formed by the Mayor and City Council in March 1997, CPARB helps promote a citizen-police partnership, and reviews and comments on police investigations of citizen complaints.

Advisory members must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a resident of the City of Tucson
- Must never have been convicted of a felony
- Must not currently be a peace officer
- Must attend monthly CPARB meetings
- Must participate in Board activities and appropriate training

Persons interested in becoming a non-voting advisory member to CPARB, should submit a letter of interest (not to exceed three pages) with the following information:

- Complete name, address and telephone number
- Brief description of prior and current community involvement
- Brief summary of what the applicant hopes to accomplish by working with CPARB
