Meetings will be held for the next 6 months to discuss the concept and develop a draft Historic Landmark Sign Code amendment. The amendment will be reviewed by the Tucson-Pima County Historical Commission and the Citizens Sign Code Committee for a recommendation to the Mayor and Council for ordinance adoption.
