AMENDMENTS TO THE PARKING CODE: VEHICLE STACKING – PRELIMINARY RECOMMENDATION

Definition: Vehicle stacking refers to an area designed to accommodate vehicles waiting in line to receive a service.

Minimum Number of Spaces

Gasoline Fuel Pump Island	2	Fueling position
Gatehouse, staffed	4	Gatehouse
Gate, unstaffed	2	Gate
Pharmacy Pick-up	3	Window
Restaurant Drive-Through with combined order/pick-up windows	6/window	Order/Pick-Up Window
Restaurant Drive-Through with separate order and pick-up windows	6 4	Order Point Pick-Up Window
Valet Parking	4	Valet Stand

Design of Stacking Spaces

- A. Each stacking space shall be a minimum of eight (8) feet in width and twenty-five (25) feet in length.
- B. Stacking spaces shall not impede on- or off-site traffic movements or movements into or out of off-street parking spaces.
- C. Stacking spaces shall be separated from other internal driveways by raised medians if deemed necessary by the Zoning Administrator for safety.
