TODD M. HARRIS SPORTS COMPLEX DEDICATION FRIDAY, JULY 19

Tucson Mayor Jonathan Rothschild, Ward 4 Tucson City Council Member Shirley Scott, Ward 2 City Council Member Paul Cunningham, Tucson Parks and Recreation, and the family of Todd M. Harris invite you to celebrate the renaming of Golf Links Sports Complex to Todd M. Harris Sports Complex.

Army Sgt. 1st Class Todd M. Harris was a graduate of Sahuaro High School. He joined the Army in 1998 and spent his career serving our nation. Harris deployed to Afghanistan in 2002, Iraq in 2003, and Suriname in 2008. His final call of duty was in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in 2010. Harris died Nov. 3, 2010, in Badghis Province, Afghanistan. On that date, he paid the ultimate price of freedom.

Harris's awards include five Army Commendation Medals, four Army Achievement Medals, five Army Good Conduct Medals, the National Defense Service Medal, and the Afghanistan Campaign Medal. In addition, he received the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Special Forces Tab, Combat Infantryman Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge. All awards were in recognition of his valor as a soldier.
