Senior Softball Opportunities Around Tucson

Softball is played year round in Tucson, offering many opportunities to players 50+ years old.

Pick-up Games

Players gather for pick-up games each Tuesday and Friday at Murrieta Park in Tucson. Games begin at 8:00 AM during the summer and 9:00 AM the rest of the year. All are welcome. This is a great way to get acquainted with senior softball players in Tucson, and will easily lead a newcomer to leagues.

Leagues

Tucson Senior Softball League (TSSL)

This league comprises 15-20 teams divided into divisions based upon team ability. Games are scheduled from the end of January to Thanksgiving. Players must register with a team before being allowed to participate. The venue is Murrieta and Santa Cruz Parks on Sundays. Contact Art Kaun (art.kaun@outlook.com).

Southern Arizona Softball League

65s League

Saddlebrooke Senior Softball Association (SSSA) Leagues

Saddlebrooke is a senior retirement resort community on the northern edge of metropolitan Tucson. The softball association provides year-round play in Saddlebrooke on one of the finest softball fields in southern Arizona and is available to senior men and women players who are 50 years or older. It has four

leagues of varying skill levels from recreation to competitive. While most of the 175 players reside in Saddlebrooke, the association membership is available to players from Oro Valley north to the Saddlebrooke Ranch senior retirement community near Oracle. BAJA Sporting Club

This league is located in Green Valley, about 20 miles south of Tucson. Green Valley is a retirement community that sees its population swell with Winter visitors. The second is the "Memorial Holiday Classic" in early December organized by TSSL. Both are held at Lincoln Park and are announced by flyers well in advance. Several teams from Tucson attend tournaments year round in different parts of Arizona. At least 25 such tournaments occur each year. During the cooler months, they occur in the valleys and during the summer in mountain locations. Some traveling teams from Tucson play in SSUSA tournaments.
