Permit Fees for Temporary Signs (per Administrative Manual 4-01.16.)

Temporary Signs are limited to commercial uses within commercial, industrial and PAD zones.
(7A.10.4 of the Unified Development Code)

Sign Type	Information	Permit duration	Permit Fee
Banners	Maximum size is 90 square feet. <i>In Historic Zones, 40 square feet is the maximum size and prior permission for display is required.</i> A maximum of one (1) banner may be displayed per street front.	Permit increments of 45 days display, with up to 90 days can be on one (1) permit. A maximum of two (2) banners may be on one (1) permit at a 90 day duration.	\$34.38 per 45 days display of one (1) banner.
Pennants & Hula Strips	Display criteria: maintain 15 feet clearance over vehicle use areas, and 8 feet over pedestrian areas. Secure strands to the building and ground, and on private property.	Display duration on a permit is 45 days, with a maximum of 90 days display allowed per year. One (1) permit can be obtained for the full 90 day display desired.	\$68.75 per 45 days display
*Balloons	Limit one (1) commercial balloon per establishment, must be displayed/secured to ground. Balloons can also be permitted as a grouped bunch, such as an arch display. No animation is permitted.	Maximum display 10 days per year. Range of 1 to 10 days display can be obtained per permit.	\$17.16 per day
