TPD GRATEFULLY RECEIVES DONATED DEFIBRILLATORS THROUGH 100+ WOMEN WHO CARE TUCSON AND THE STEVEN M. GOOTTER FOUNDATION.

At a press conference on Tuesday, June 22nd, Tucson Police Chief Chris Magnus will accept the donation of 25 AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators) from the local chapter of 100+ Women Who Care and the Steven M. Gootter Foundation.

Being out in the community, police are often the first to arrive at the scene of a medical emergency. Having lifesaving equipment such as AEDs provides more opportunity to save more lives.

“We’re extremely grateful to have these tools at our patrol officers’ disposal,” said TPD Chief Chris Magnus. “Seconds count when cardiac arrest happens, and it’s often police officers who are first on the scene of a medical emergency. These are truly lifesaving gifts.”

100+ Women Who Care Tucson is a group of local women who combine their donations to have a greater impact. The Steven M. Gootter Foundation is dedicated to saving lives by defeating sudden cardiac death through increased awareness, education, scientific research and the distribution of AEDs.
