HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 400 BLOCK OF EAST PRINCE ROAD

On June 11, 2022, at approximately 4:48 a.m., the Public Safety Communications Department received several 911 calls reporting gunfire in the 400 block of E. Prince Rd. Officers from Operations Division West responded to an apartment complex and located an adult male victim in the courtyard who was transported to Banner University Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries.

Officers made contact at an apartment within the complex and located two adult males on the floor inside. Both males were pronounced deceased at the scene. They have been identified as 50-year-old **Ricky Green** and 23-year-old **Romeo Salaz**. Next of kin have been notified of their passing. Homicide Detectives were contacted and responded to continue the investigation. Detectives learned that Mr. Green and Mr. Salaz were involved in an attempted robbery of the victim. During the course of the robbery, a physical altercation occurred, and several shots were fired, striking Mr. Green, Mr. Salaz, and the victim.

A search warrant was obtained for the residence, which yielded additional evidence. At the conclusion of the search warrant and interviews, no arrests were made at this time, and detectives believe there are no outstanding suspects. Detectives will present their findings to the Pima County Attorney's Office for further review. Additional details will be release when they become available.
