FATAL MOTORCYCLE COLLISION SOUTH KOLB ROAD AND EAST KENYON DRIVE

On July 4, 2021, at approximately 10:27 p.m., officers from Operations Division East were dispatched to the intersection of S. Kolb Rd. and E. Kenyon Dr. for a serious-injury collision involving a motorcycle. Tucson Fire personnel responded and began rendering aid. The rider of a silver 2007 Harley-Davidson XL1200 motorcycle was pronounced deceased at the scene. He has been identified as 57-year-old **Derek Bruce Post**. Next of kin has been notified.

Traffic Unit Detectives were contacted and responded to the scene and continued the investigation. Interviews conducted by officers and detectives determined that Mr. Post was traveling southbound on Kolb Rd. At this time a blue 2015 Toyota Tundra was making a left-turn from S. Kolb Rd. on to E. Kenyon Dr. Mr. Post struck the passenger side of the Tundra.

The driver of the Tundra remained on scene. An officer from the Impaired Driving Enforcement Unit responded to the scene and determined that the driver was not impaired at the time of the collision. Interviews in conjunction with roadway evidence have determined that failing to yield making a left-turn by the Tundra and excessive speed by Mr. Post are major contributing factors in the collision.

This is an ongoing investigation and no charges or citations have been issued at this time.
