### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 100 BLOCK OF WEST KENTUCKY STREET

**\*\*\*UPDATE – June 21, 2022\*\*\***

As the investigation continued into the fatal shooting of Alma Gomez, detectives learned that prior to the shooting, the suspects had forced their way into the home to rob the occupants. After the home invasion, the suspects fled in a vehicle. Investigators also believe that the suspects and home occupants knew each other. Detectives obtained and served numerous warrants which led them to identify 18-year-old **Rene Alejandro Uranga**, 18-year-old **Luis Isaiah Navarro** and 19-year-old **Anyssa Delfina Rios-Sanchez** as suspects in this case.

On June 15, 2022, TPD SWAT and Community Response Team Officers (CRT) from the South, West, and East Divisions served arrest warrants and took Uranga and Navarro into custody. Detectives conducted additional interviews and ultimately charged both suspects with Armed Robbery, Kidnapping, and Felony Murder. Uranga and Navarro were transported and booked into the Pima County Jail – they are each being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. On June 17, 2022, Rios-Sanchez turned herself into detectives and is being held on a \$500,000 bond. She is also charged with Armed Robbery, Kidnapping and Felony Murder. The investigation remains on-going and detectives are asking anyone with information to call 88-CRIME. You can remain anonymous.

Officer Francisco Magos – June 21, 2022

May 2, 2022 – Officers from Operations Division South were dispatched to a home in the 100 block of W. Kentucky St. for a report of a shooting. Officers arrived at approximately 2:00 a.m. and located an adult female in the home with gunshot trauma. Officers immediately began rendering aid until Tucson Fire Department personnel arrived. Despite life-saving efforts, the victim succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Officers identified the victim as 40-year-old **Alma Daniela Gomez**. Next of kin was notified.

Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit were notified and responded to continue the investigation. Detectives served a search warrant on the home and processed the scene. Investigators are in the course of locating and interviewing witnesses to the incident. There are no suspects in custody; however, initial details suggest that the shooting was not a random act.
