HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 6516 EAST STELLA ROAD

Detectives with the Tucson Police Department Violent Crimes Unit are investigating a fatal shooting that occurred yesterday evening on Tucson's Eastside.

On April 24, 2022, Officers from Operations Division East responded to a home located at 6516 E. Stella Rd. just after 8:30 p.m. in regards to a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male with gunshot trauma inside the home. Officers rendered aid until Tucson Fire Department personnel arrived and transported him to St. Joseph's Hospital. Despite life-saving efforts, the male succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased. Officers identified the male as 44-year-old **William Hall**. His family was notified of his death. Detectives were briefed on the incident and undertook the investigation.

According to interviews conducted at the scene, detectives learned that Mr. Hall had arrived to the home, hours earlier, at which time he became involved in a confrontation with the home's occupants. As the argument progressed, a physical altercation ensued. During the altercation in the home, Mr. Hall was struck by gunfire. Shortly after the gunfire, the Public Safety Communications Department (PSCD) began receiving reports of the shooting. No other injuries were reported to police. After examining evidence and interview summaries, detectives believe Mr. Hall and the residents knew each other.

Anyone with information is asked to call 88-CRIME. Detectives are still continuing the investigation; however, no arrests have been made at this time and no suspects are being sought by police. Once the investigation is complete, detectives will present their findings to the Pima County Attorney's Office for review.
