### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION EAST PRINCE ROAD AND NORTH STONE AVENUE

On the morning of May 11, 2022, police officers from Operations Division West were dispatched to a report of a shooting near E. Prince Rd. and N. Stone Ave. Officers arrived just after 5:45 a.m. and located a vehicle in the roadway – east of the intersection – with two victims nearby. One of the victims, an 18-year-old female, was found unresponsive with gunshot trauma. Officers performed CPR and rendered aid until Tucson Fire Department Medics arrived. Despite lifesaving efforts, the female died at the scene. She was identified as **Emma Maria Destiny Dominguez**. Next of kin has been notified. The second victim, an adult female, was treated at the scene for minor injuries.

Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit were briefed and undertook the investigation. According to several witnesses and evidence collected from the scene, detectives learned that the shooting took place west of N. Stone Ave. on W. Fort Lowell Road. After the shooting, the victims drove to Prince Road, where officers located them. A description of the suspect and suspect vehicle were developed by detectives, which was forwarded to Operations Division West/Community Response Team (ODW/CRT). Through additional interviews and review of evidence, investigators identified the suspect as 20-year-old **Andres Machado**.

On the evening of May 12, 2022, Machado was taken in to custody with the assistance of TPD SWAT, K9 Units, ODW/CRT and ODS/CRT. Detectives obtained and served an additional search warrant – ultimately charging Andres Machado with 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder and Aggravated Assault/Deadly Weapon. Machado was transported and booked into the Pima County Jail where he is being held without bond. No additional suspects are being sought and detectives discovered that the involved parties knew each other.
