HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION SOUTH LOSTAN AVENUE AND WEST IRVINGTON ROAD

The Tucson Police Department is currently investigating a fatal shooting that occurred last night on Tucson's South Side.

On August 9, 2021, just after 9:45 p.m., the Public Safety Communications Department received several 9-1-1 calls reporting shots fired in the area of S. Liberty Ave. and W. Irvington Road. Officers from Operations Division South were dispatched to the area. As officers arrived, they located a shooting victim near S. Lostan Ave. and W. Irvington Rd. Officers immediately began rendering aid to the male victim. Tucson Fire Department personnel responded and ultimately transported him to Banner University Medical Center with life-threatening injuries. Hours after arriving to the hospital, the victim succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased. Officers identified the victim as 37-year-old **Domingo Sebastian Molina**. His family was notified of his passing.

Homicide Unit Detectives were briefed and responded to continue the investigation. After processing the scene and conducting interviews, detectives believe this was not a random shooting and are actively pursuing leads to identify the suspect. Detectives are asking anyone with information to call 88-CRIME. You can remain anonymous. Additional updates will be released as they become available.
