

Clean Up After Your Critters

Why clean up animal waste?

Animal waste contains bacteria that can pollute stormwater and be transported to our fragile desert washes. It can harm the environment and may pose a risk to children, pets and wildlife. Dispose of waste properly.

How do I dispose of pet waste?

Bag your pet's waste and put it in the garbage. Don't leave pet waste in your yard and never dispose of it in washes or in the desert. Pet waste does not just "go away" and it doesn't turn into fertilizer.

Bag it → Toss it in the trash!

What about horse manure?

Cover manure and transport it in a truck or a trailer to the landfill. Residential animal waste is accepted for \$10 per ton. Small quantities may be bagged and deposited in a dumpster.
